

Keeping Safe

Smoking, including e-cigarettes, is not allowed on school premises.

Dogs are not allowed on the school grounds even if they are carried.

We are a lollipop free school! Please do not send lollipops into school as they can be a choking hazard.

For crime prevention and public safety, we have CCTV cameras around the school site, including in the main office and the Thompson centre.

At playtimes the children have access to a wide range of play equipment including skipping ropes, hoops, stilts, balls and much more. We have high numbers of staff out on the playground to promote safe use of this equipment and children are shown how to use new equipment safely. In fine weather, Junior children use the school filed.

All accidents are recorded in a school log. All bumps to the head are reported immediately by phone call or text. High impact accidents will be reported to parents/carers using an accident report form that you will be asked to sign.

Footballs and rugby balls are not allowed to be brought into school.

Children must not play on the Nursery play equipment at the end of the day.

Adults must make sure their own language is appropriate for school premises: no swearing.

Children must not ride bikes or play football outside the front entrance before or after school.
