- In Reception, we have been reading 'The Pirates Next Door', learning about pirates and preparing for our Father's Day celebrations.


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- In Year 1 we have been continuing to make lots of different crafts for our sing for songbirds project. We really enjoyed having our grownups come in for some Father's day crafts.
