In **Nursery**, we have started to learn about journeys and transport. The children talked about how they travel to school and after making a chart, used their counting and number skills to talk about what it showed. This week in **Reception** the children have explored our new book "The Sea Saw". The children have enjoyed sharing something special to them and writing about Sofia's journey to the seaside. The Children have enjoyed learning about the coast and what we might find on our trip to New Brighton next week! The children have discussed the importance of digital wellbeing.

This week **Year 1** have been listening to lots of stories all about the Big Bad Wolf to help create some wanted posters. The children have been introduced to the work of William Morris to help create their own patterns next week.

Year 2 have enjoyed reading more of their class book The Enchanted Wood and used this to inspire us when planning our own story adventures to an imaginary land at the top of the Magic Faraway Tree. We have also started our new project all about the Seaside and have been learning lots of new vocabulary in preparation for our trip next week.

Year 3 have enjoyed learning all about the Great Fire of London this week – how it started and why it spread! We have been looking at different sources like diary entries and newspapers from the time!

This week **Year 4** have been learning about life in England after the Romans. The children have been introduced to the epic old English poem Beowulf and enjoyed finding out about the different tribes that made up the group of people we now refer to as the 'Anglo-Saxons', where they came from and how they lived.

This week, **Year 5** have been building their knowledge of working with decimals and converting fractions into decimals. In English, the children are really enjoying our new book The Titanic Detective Agency. The children have been looking closely at the characters so far. During our topic work the children have planned a holiday to Egypt!

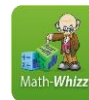
