This week in **Reception**, we had our fun day. The children bounced on the bouncy castle, had our faces painted and enjoyed an ice cream. The children learnt about Flotsam and used their amazing imaginations to create their own underwater world.

This week in **Year 1** the children have finished their learning in maths around positional language; with a focus on using vocabulary such as right, left, forwards, backwards, besides, quarter turn, half turn and full turn. In DT we have also created moving images using sliders and pivots.

Year 2 have loved getting started on TTRS this week and earning lots of virtual coins to spend as they become more confident answering multiplication and division questions. They've also been so impressive typing up their own Magic Faraway Tree stories ready to publish into their own class book!

Year 3 have been looking at the artist David Hockney, we have loved creating beautiful landscapes with watercolours as well as some digital collages – all inspired by his work! We have also been looking at pollination and fertilisation in our plants unit in science.

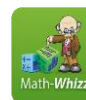
