This Week's Highlights

In **Nursery** we have listened to the story "Pete the cat rocking in his school shoes", looking at the areas that Pete the cat has in his school and the areas that the children explore in Nursery. The children talked about what they like to do in the different areas in Nursery.

This week in **Reception**, we have been practising our letter formation and exploring the number 2. Using our book focus, 'Peace at Last', the children thought about the order of the story and why Mr. Bear couldn't sleep. We also admired the illustrations in the book and had a go at drawing our own bears. They were amazing!

This week in **Year 1** we have used our own ideas in English to write wanted posters for the missing wolf. We also worked hard to make sure our letters were formed with increased accuracy using the lines in our books.

Year 2 enjoyed learning about the seven continents in their geography work this week, we listened to a super catchy song to help us remember all seven and where they are on a map. The children have also been working hard in their DT lessons to make design choices for their product of a travel bag.

Year 3 have been continuing our science topic all about light. This week we have been testing different materials to find out how reflective they are! In English, we have started a new book called 'Orion and the Dark'. We have been building super descriptive sentences all about night-time

This week, **Year 4** have been working hard in their computing lessons to learn how to insert, format and resize a picture into a document. We have also enjoyed reading a poem set in the rainforest and are beginning to learn about the different animals and trees that form part of this incredible natural resource through our new Literacy focus story The Great Kapok Tree.

This week, **Year 5** have enjoyed working scientifically. This week they have investigated 'How the surface area of an object effects the rate it falls'. They enjoyed making four different sized parachutes and tested which fell at a slower speed because of air resistance.

This week, **Year 6** have worked their little socks off. They have learned about how different animals, from different environments have adapted so they can survive the conditions. We have continued our story of The House with the Chicken Legs and have written amazing descriptive pieces about the house.

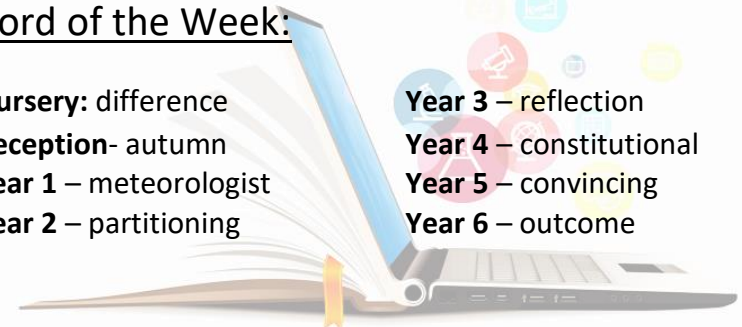
