Reading

This Week's Highlights

In **Nursery** we have focused our learning on the story "The 3 little pigs", the children have used a story map to develop their story telling skills. They have explored the materials used by the pigs to make their homes and looked at features of houses, looking at similarities and differences.

This week in **Reception**, we have continued to learn more about Autumn by reading the book Leaf Man. We have developed our phonics skills by starting to listen for initial sounds as well being to write small words. We have explored the number 4 and looked for what numbers we can find in 4.

This week in **Year 1** had a fabulous time at Z Arts in Manchester. They explored Fairy Tale town and used their imagination to explore the different areas.

Year 2 have enjoyed learning how to thread a needle and use the running stitch in their DT lessons. The children showed great resilience and are looking forward to using this skill when making their bags. In maths we have been exploring lots of number lines and estimating missing numbers using our place value knowledge.

Year 3 have had lots of fun this week building shadow puppet theatres to help with a science investigation on shadows. We have also been working incredibly hard on adding and subtracting tens and hundreds from 3-digit numbers!

This week, **Year 4** have been writing a setting description based in the rainforest. We have enjoyed learning the scientific names for each of the layers and exploring the wide range of weird and wonderful animals who inhabit these amazing habitats!

This week, **Year 5** have been planning and writing their letters to Mrs Dingsdale in the hope they can persuade her to allow us a school pet. We will keep you updated on how they get on! We have also enjoyed finding out about different gears, levers and pulleys in science and how they can help us in today's society.

This week, **Year 6** have continued our sign language lessons and learned the signs for different animals as well as finishing signing the song 'Shut Up and Dance with Me'. We have begun to look at the Amazon Rainforest in geography and identified the different layers in it. We've had a great week!

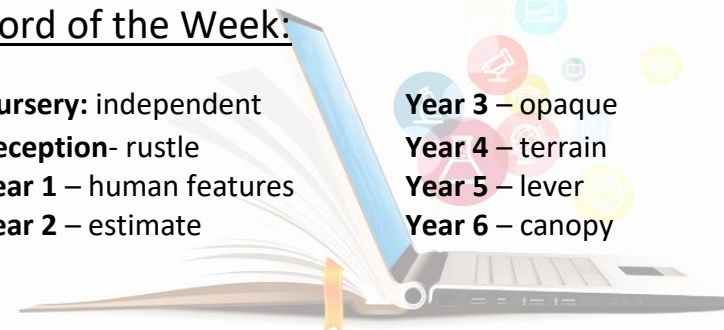
