In **Nursery** we have continued to learn about celebrations – we were very excited to talk about our own experiences of Hallowe'en, sharing our photographs from home. We also learned about Bonfire night, talking about what we can see and hear as we watched a video clip of fireworks. We also learned how to keep safe on Bonfire night and many of us are looking forward to celebrating with our families.

This week in **Reception**, we started by looking at the celebration of Halloween. We discussed various traditions and ways people celebrate. Year 2 have worked super hard this week to put all of their DT skills into practise and sew their bags together. The children have also enjoyed using their imaginations to imagine a perfect day in Australia to write a diary entry about!
