Reading

This Week's Highlights

In **Nursery** the children have been retelling the story of "We're going on a leaf hunt" using actions as well. We have continued to learn about the season of Autumn, creating a hedgehog using playdough and craft materials. The children have also learned about patterns that we see around us, stripes, spots, checked pattern etc. The children played a pattern matching game and were encouraged to name the pattern.

This week in **Reception**, we have read the story Superworm. We enjoyed drawing other things Superworm could be to help his friends and labelled our work. We have explored the words longest and shortest by measuring different worms and had lots of fun painting with 'worms!'

This week in **Year 1** we have enjoyed exploring settings in different stories ready to write our own story. In maths we have been using our number bond knowledge to solve maths problems. We have enjoyed creating our own family timelines in history and discussed different materials in science. We have also started to learn Christmas songs ready for our singalong!

Year 2 have enjoyed starting their new history topic this week which is all about the history of flight! The children used a historical object to make some enquiries about our learning before finding out about the Wright brothers and that we will be learning all about them! The children have also enjoyed using the book "paper planes" in our English work.

This week in **Year 3** we have started a few new topics! In science, we will be learning all about forces and magnets. In geography, we have been learning about the compass points and the regions in England, before moving on to looking at counties and cities in the North West. In DT, we have started a new sewing topic, making a magnetic fishing game!

This week, **Year 4** have started our new Geography topic focusing on learning all about Europe. We have looked at the oceans and sea surrounding the island of Britain and had a competition to see who could locate nine named European countries the fastest! We would love to hear about the children's experiences of Europe, either through travelling for holidays, visiting family members who live there or discussing their own immediate heritage and sharing things of interest/importance to them regarding this.

This week, **Year 5** have 'launched' their new science topic about space. The children were excited to find out that NASA had launched the Artemis space rocket on the same day we launched our new topic. What a great coincidence! The children were fascinated watching the space rocket 'lift off' and are all looking forward to finding out more over the coming weeks. The children have also impressed us with their emotional letters they have completed as a character from our class novel Private Peaceful. Well done everyone.

This week, **Year 6** have been finding out about how the second world war started and the way this affected people living in Britain with conscription, rationing and blackouts. We learned how to sign different food and drinks and began to sign "rolling on the river". We also designed our phone cases in DT and the children who went swimming were praised by the staff at the baths for excellent attitude and behaviour.
