In **Nursery** this week, we have used the song "We all go travelling by" to focus our learning on our topic "Transport and journeys". The children have talked about how they travel to school and which other vehicles they have used. The children have also created a card and biscuits to share on Father's Day.

This week in **Reception**, we have begun our new topic learning about journeys. We have looked at Barnaby Bear and some of the places he has been on a journey too and compared them. We talked about where we would like to go on a journey.

This week in **Year 1**, we have really enjoyed exploring our new book Speak Up! A girl called Rocket used her voice to make a difference and when her library was at risk of closing like ours. We are inspired to speak up ourselves! In maths we have started to understand fractions and have been splitting numbers into halves and quarters! Our sunflowers have started to grow, and we have created a design brief for our new DT project. What a busy week!

**Year 2** have been very excited this week with the arrival of their class caterpillars. It has inspired their amazing writing as they wrote all about a real event and also provided an extra stimulus for their art work. The children loved exploring the different sketching pencils and techniques this week to create different tones in their drawings.

This week in **Year 3**, we have started our new science topic on plants and have started to conduct our first investigation into the requirements plants need for growth and life. We have also started our new geography unit on our local area and understanding some OS map symbols.

This week, in **Year 4** we have completed our Maths unit of work on fractions, started writing our own original stories based on the 'Birthday Bunny' and pulled together all of the drawing skills we learned last half term to create our own pieces of art work-we are very excited to see the completed results!

**Year 5** have this week; we have enjoyed researching about Malala Yousafzai's life and how she has campaigned for equal rights and specifically equal education in Pakistan. We cannot wait to read their information texts next week! In Maths, we have continued with fractions looking at finding fractions of quantities and amounts.

**Year 6** have been putting their all into singing and dancing ready for our performance which will be happening in a few weeks. We've continued our learning about trade and know the different stages involved in producing chocolate, we also really enjoyed learning about the history of Sutton Manor Colliery and other coal mines in our town. We loved finding out about Adonna Khare in our art lessons too.


