This Week's Highlights

In **Nursery** this week we created a story map to help us to retell the story of our trip to New Brighton. The children also took part in a Road safety session where they learned about how to travel safely in a car; ensuring that the seat belt is fastened. They also learned about making sure that they hold the adults hand when walking in the street.

This week in **Reception**, we read the story The Pirate Cruncher!! We've had lots of fun writing letters to persuade pirates to come to visit Cruncher Island. We have been drawing and writing our own treasure maps and also we have been designing and creating our own puppets just like in the Pirate Cruncher.

This week in **Year 1**, we have loved exploring the trees on our field to find out if there are more deciduous or evergreen trees on there. In maths, we have been learning about money and the different values of each coin. In English, we have started our new book 'Journey' and can't wait to see where it takes us.

Year 2 have been very busy this week learning the column method in maths and exploring story mountains in English. We've all loved watching our Caterpillars / Butterflies over the last few weeks and released them on the school field on Thursday morning which was very exciting for all the children to see.

This week in **Year 3**, this week we have been continuing our learning about local history and geography. We have been conducting some fieldwork in our town centre, comparing what it looked like in the past to what it looks like today. We really enjoyed our trip to The World of Glass and were very excited to see a demonstration of glass blowing, and to take a tour of the tunnels.

This week, in **Year 4** we have been immersing ourselves in our new local history topic and researching lots of information about our very successful rugby team. The children were amazed to find out how successful the Saints team have been throughout the years and have very much enjoyed comparing the cost of tickets then and now, looking at the changing kits and developing their Geography skills by locating the new and old stadiums on a map. We have also been delighted to welcome a former Saints player Peter Harvey, who shared some fascinating stories, including what it felt like to walk out onto the pitch at the 1966 Wembley final!

Year 5 have immersed themselves in our new local history topic all about David Gamble and the Gamble Institute. We had a very knowledgeable visitor from Momo's who has shared with the children and staff lots of interesting facts about our topic.
