This Week's Highlights

In **Nursery** we have continued to learn the words and actions to retell the story – Jack and the Beanstalk. The children have continued their learning about what plants need to grow and have prepared a gift and card to say thank you to the special ladies in their life – we wish all of the Mums, Nans, Aunties and big sisters a special day on Sunday.

In **Reception** we been learning about Noah's Ark. The children have enjoyed writing about the ark and its animals during our Drawing Club. In maths, we have looked at how many animals can fit on each ark based on their leg count; we have practised using our new word, 'estimate'. World Book Day brought lots of excitement and we loved seeing all of the children in their costumes/outfits. The children enjoyed their special visitors from St. Peter's Church who retold the story of Noah's ark from the bible. The children have also been very crafty this week, creating things for Mother's Day.

In **Year 1** we have read our new book "How to Catch A Star". We have enjoyed exploring the emotions of the character and creating a story map. We loved writing a list of things to take with us on a star hunt. In Maths we are now working with numbers to 50! In science we examined animal poo (playdough!) to find out what they ate so we could group them as herbivores, carnivores, or omnivores.

This week **Year 2** have really enjoyed working with Tracy from St. Helens chamber to see what sort of skills they will need in order to be successful in their future careers. The children loved world book day and getting to just "drop everything and read" as well as designing their own dragon, just in time too as we have had our very own dragon fruits delivered to class. The children are keeping a close eye on them so that we are ready for when they hatch into baby dragons.

In **Year 3** we have started our new text "Tuesday". We predicted what we thought would happen in the book, using the image on the front cover to help. In science, we looked at the three main functions of the human endoskeleton and we learned the scientific names for some of the bones in our body!

In **Year 4** we have had a wonderful time celebrating world book day and using our creative skills to complete some beautiful Mother's Day cards and fantastic forest school crafts. We have continued to develop our Maths skills and extended our knowledge to learn how to work out the perimeter of polygons this week and have been busy planning our non-chronological reports on the Romans.

In **Year 5**, we have enjoyed Book Week! On Thursday, we had some fabulous costumes and enjoyed the Book Day activities. We even had a surprise guest visit from past captain James Roby and some of his ex-teammates!

This week in **Year 6** we have had a great day celebrating book day, taking part in some fantastic activities. Our children looked great! We have finished our landlady writing and have done a fabulous job of it. We have begun work on area and perimeter in maths. We've also learned about the vicious Vikings and how they raided Lindisfarne.

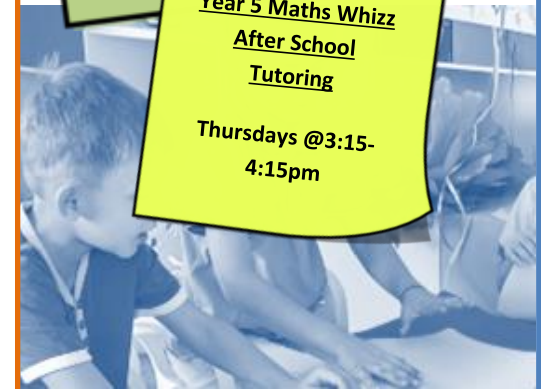
Reminders
