Peter McGraith and David Cabreza from north London had been partners for 17 years before they tied the knot at one-minute past midnight on 29 March 2014, making them the first same-sex couple to marry in the UK after the passing of the Marriage (Same Sex Couples) Act 2013.

★ I know the difference between an active and passive bystander and I can give examples of how these two different behaviours have an impact on a situation where someone is being bullied.

Assertiveness

Confident and forceful behaviour.

Cooperation

The action or process of working together to the same end.

Compromise

An agreement or settlement of a dispute that is reached by each side making concessions.

Bystander

A person who is present at an event or incident but does not take part.

Negotiation

Discussion aimed at reaching an agreement.

Appropriate touch

Touches that keep children safe and are good for them, and that make children feel cared for and important.

Inappropriate touch

Any form of touch that makes someone uncomfortable.

Content

Any material available on the Web. Online content includes text, images, animations, music and videos.

Anonymous

Where a person's name and identity is unknown. Influence

The ability to have an effect on the character, development, or behaviour of someone or something.

Implication

The effect that an action or decision will have on something else in the future.

Addiction

Not having control over doing, taking or using something to the point where it could be harmful

to you. **Substance**

Something (such as drugs or alcohol) deemed harmful and usually subject to legal restriction.

Isolation

The condition of being alone, especially when this makes you feel unhappy.

Pressure Group

A term used to describe a voluntary group of people who share a common cause and wish to influence decisions affecting their cause by putting pressure on decision-makers.

Environmental Sustainability

preserving natural resources so that future generations can enjoy the benefits they bring

Democracy

a system of government by the whole population or all the eligible members of a state, typically through elected representatives.

Public Services

a resource offered by an organization, typically a government agency or private business, intended to support members of a community.

Awareness

knowledge or perception of a situation or fact

Budget

allow or provide a particular amount of money in a budget.

a study which figures out how people, businesses and groups make and use money
