#### Reading

Please make sure you listen to your child read at least 3 times a week and record this in their reading records.

For those children not yet bringing a reading book home, please make sure you are reading to them as frequently as possible.

## This Week's Highlights

In **Nursery**, we have been learning about different farm animals. We have learned about the life cycles of chickens and frogs and talked about how the animals change in the way they look. We have been subitising up to 5 with different animals and explained what other numbers we could see.

In **Reception**, we have baked our own gingerbread houses and decorated them with delicious sweets to lure children to them like the witch in the story. In maths we have been looking at what makes an odd or even number. We have been watching our beans grow and planted them outside so they have more room to grow.

In **Year 1** we have explored the most important parts of our story The Baddies. In Science we discussed the different types of trees and the yearly cycle of a deciduous tree. In PSHE we learnt why it is important to wash our hands and how to ensure we are washing them properly. We enjoyed a workshop on other people's feelings.

Year 2 have written their own powerful shape poems this week to make us think about the effects of deforestation and the importance of protecting animal habitats. They certainly are writing pieces to be proud of! In DT we have started to make our toy structures applying our joining techniques and showing lots of resilience.

In **Year 3** we have written a balanced argument in English, looking at reasons for and against zoos. In maths, we have been continuing our work on fractions. We have been learning how to add and subtract fractions, remembering that when the denominators are the same, we only add or subtract the numerator.

In **Year** 4 we have enjoyed reading the beautiful book Henry's Freedom Box and sharing our thoughts and feelings about the characters. In Maths we have been developing our knowledge of decimals and we have spent Geography lessons looking at ordnance survey maps of Liverpool and revising the map symbols we learned in Y3 alongside learning some new ones!

In **Year 5**, we have enjoyed immersing ourselves into our new novel in English – Room 13! In Maths, we have continued to work on Statistics, learning how to plot and read line graphs. In History, we have researched about Sir David Gamble- Have you ever heard of the Gamble building?

**Year 6** have been very hard at it this week, doing last minute revision. The time is now here to put all of their hard work to the test – literally. They have been wonderful and feel ready for the challenge next week.
